Dear Families,

We are looking forward to welcoming your child into the Junior part of our school in September. All permissions for photographs, use of the internet etc will be transferred to the junior school. If you have anything to amend regarding these, please speak to the school office.

If any of your contact details have changed, please inform the office as it is very important that this information is kept up to date. All communications will be sent by email unless a reply slip is required. Therefore, it is very important that we have the correct details to contact you.

School Money: You will receive a new login and password when your child starts the junior school. Please delete the Infant login details and password as they will not be transferred over to the Junior system. If your child requires a meal in the first two days of school (Thursday 3rd/Friday 4th September), they will need to book it with their teacher and it will be added to the system. Please remember that there is a charge for school dinners. A school dinner costs £2.20. If you think you may be eligible for Free School Meals please contact the school office who will be happy to help.

New term (All arrangements subject to change dependent on government guidance)

The first day back is Thursday 3rd September. The gates to the playground usually open between 8.45am-8.55am with no parents on the playground in the morning. However, we may have to adjust this due to COVID 19 and impose a one-way system across the playground in the mornings, with the exit being through the infant playground. Registration is at 8.50am. The school day finishes at 3.15pm (playground gates are opened at 3.00pm). Again, this may be adjusted and you will be fully informed.

Due to the coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak, it will not be possible for your child to visit their new classroom and meet their teacher face to face before the Summer holidays. However, Ms Hazel has created a very detailed PowerPoint to introduce your child to year 3 (some arrangements subject to change with adjustments due to COVID-19). You will also receive an emailed letter from your child's new class teacher. Your child is invited to reply by email- Ms Hazel and Miss McGuinness will be able to answer any questions and reply with a personal email back to each child.
