## **Family Corner**

You can support your child by talking to them about trust. Ask the question: 'Who do they trust?' Or 'Who trusts them?' Consider how trust is built with other people, friends and family.

### **'Trust has to be earned'**

At home you could discuss this statement with your children and decide what you think it means.

Trust is about feeling comfortable with someone, believing that they will do the right thing and look after us. Emphasise that trust has to be earned. As you become better friends with someone, you will trust them more and your friendship will become closer. You should be able to trust your friend with things that are precious to you. When we give our trust to someone, we are confident that they won't hurt us and that they will be honest with us
