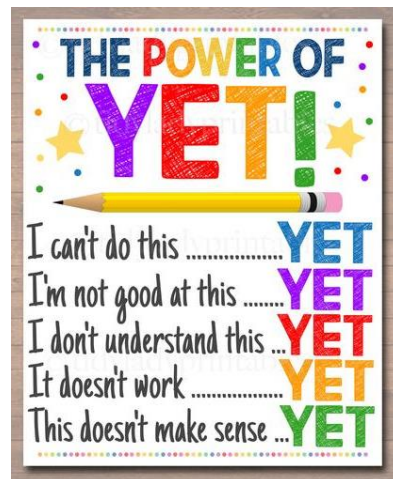


Perseverance
