### Lark Ascending by Ralph Vaughan Williams

Lark Ascending was written in 1914. It was inspired by a poem of the same name by George Meredith. Vaughan Williams began composing this music just before the start of the First World War. It describes a lark flying, gliding and soaring through the air, looking down at the fields below. This music has previously been voted the nation's favourite piece by radio audiences.
