- Do not leave electrical items switched on when you leave the house as they may overheat and cause a fire.
- Do not leave live wires exposed.
- If there is a problem with your electrics contact a qualified electrician who will be able to help.

The Fire Brigade helps people if there is a fire.

Remember to leave access for fire engines.

If you see a fire engine with blue flashing lights, it is on its way to an emergency. You should move out of the way to allow it to pass safely.

Fire stations sometimes have open days when you can visit with your family.
