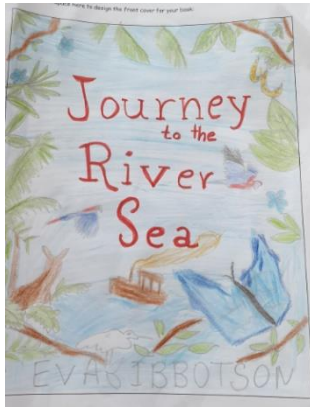

## Letter from an Evacuee

Cherry Cottage  
20th June 1940

On my journey it is ok we were a bit cramped. There was not really any body to talk to on the train. The journey took us about 6 and a half hours.

The people looking after me are #Bobthebuilder and #Alex. They are really nice and kind to me they have got 3 other children. They are called Erin and Holly. I love them they are so kind and loving.

Where I am staying is a very nice place and it is nice and cool. I live in cherry cottage. I compare my old house to this because we do not have any bombers and we won't be found to be taken away to the concentration camps.

The new school I am in is nice my teacher is very nice and kind to me and to the other children. The old school was plain and boring but the school I am in now is all nice and colourful and bright and glam.

Meals have been quite nice compare to the other dinners back home well they weren't really dinners to be honest they were just like one potato or something like that.

I also have 2 sisters. My younger sister is called Holly and my oldest sister is called Erin.

I feel happy living in the country because we have no bombers only a little bit of war and yeah I miss my mum my dad and my other siblings and some of my belongings.

## Letter from an Evacuee

Cherry Cottage  
20th June 1940

Dear family

The journey was long but fun. We got drinks and food and smelted the fresh air and slept there where a lot of cows and birds. I counted 66 cows and 172 birds. The seats were red with blue handles. There were lots of children on the train.

Me, grace and lilly met a girl called Ashley, who was going to the same house as us. She is 12 (1 year older than me). We did a lot of things like eye spy, singing and smelted the fresh air which smelled like wet grass. I am being looked after by Vicky Smith she is very nice and play with me, grace, lilly and Ashley. She plays us to do work. She also helps us with homework. Altogether she is really nice to everyone except our lene the rude shop owner (Vicky's old boss).

I am staying in a big house. We that is next to ruby beach which is in America. There are three guest rooms one for me one for Ashley and lilly and grace share a bed. There are lots of birds fly everywhere. Me, Ashley and Vicky go and work at market and sell post cards for 24. Grace and lilly play with rocks and sticks in the back.

The school is very different to the one back home. It is really hard to catch up with everyone else since I haven't learned the stuff they learned. My teacher (Mrs Storm) put all of us evacuees in a little work group so we can catch up on all the work that we missed.

The food has been really good. We mostly had fish and chips because we live near a beach. We also eat crabs and other sea food. Ashley is vegetarian so she eats fruits and vegetables.

lilly and grace love it here and they even made a friend that is 11 (one year older than them). We have made cakes, zippy radish salad and spam musubi. They look like they are having fun. We all miss you very much and can't wait to see you again.

Most of the time I feel safe because I am out of harms way. I hope you are safe and doing well. See you soon.

Choose an animal to fit into each of the groups below and then write an explanation of how you know.

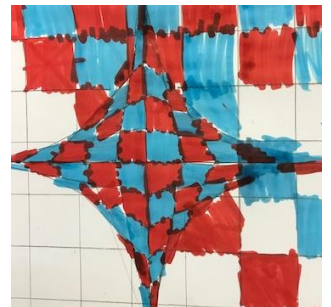
Groups	Picture	Explanation
Mammals		Mammals are animals that breathe air, they are born and grow. They all have milk during its life. Pandas, sheep, and cats are all mammals and give their parents' milk when they are born.
Fish		Fish are all-bearing aquatic animals that look like fish. They are cold-blooded and swim with scales and have fins for movements.
Reptiles		Reptiles are air-breathing vertebrates covered in special skin made up with scales, bony plates, or a combination of both. They include lizards and snakes.
Amphibians		Amphibians are a vertebrate class of animals with an aquatic and an air-breathing stage which means that their body temperature changes with their surroundings.
Birds		Birds are a group of warm-blooded vertebrates whose distinctive feature is feathers. They have beaks, two hard-shelled eggs which hatch into a young, feathered bird.

Cherry Cottage  
20th June 1940

Dear Mama,  
Papa and family,

How are you all? Peter and I are both fine. It's been a few weeks since we arrived here now and we both miss you all very very much. In the first week in was really difficult for me and especially Peter. The reason was because the family who adopted us wasn't Jewish like us and they didn't speak German, so they would act out what they want to say and we would guess what they are saying.
