During the autumn term we will be focussing on Geography and Design and Technology.

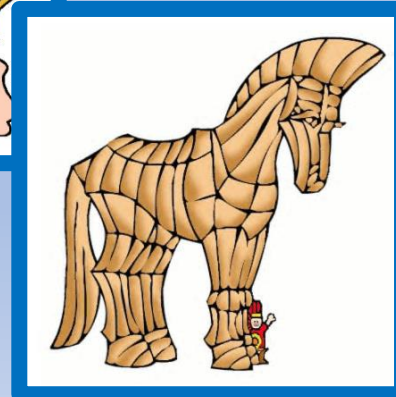
We will be learning about the tropical rainforests and Polar Regions of the world.

PE

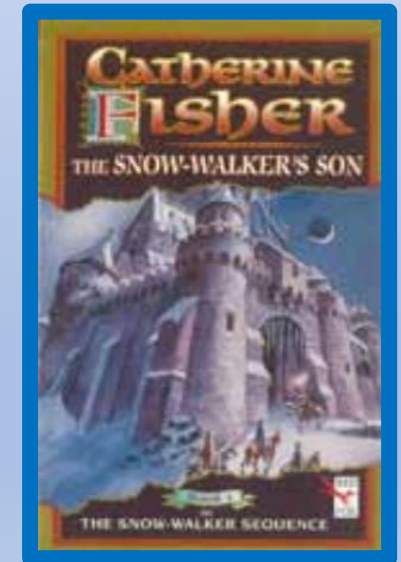
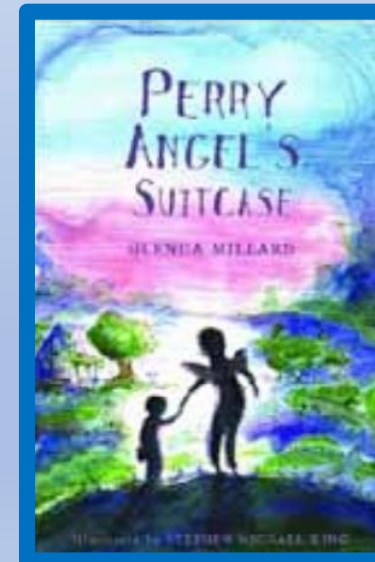
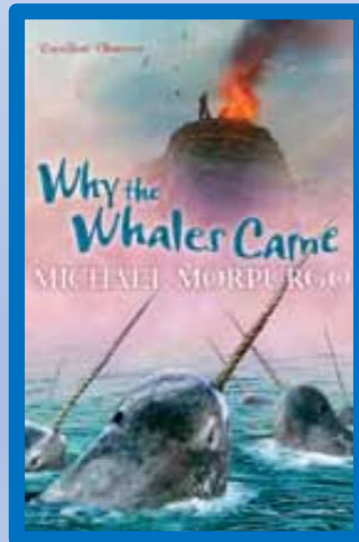
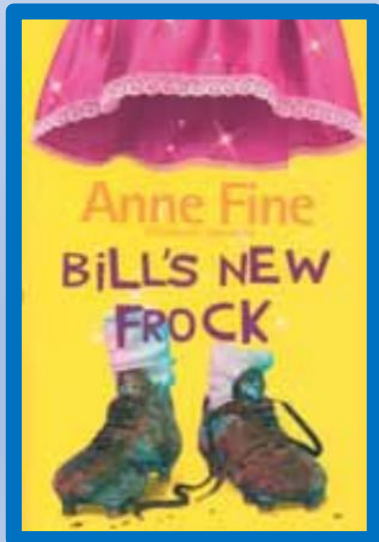
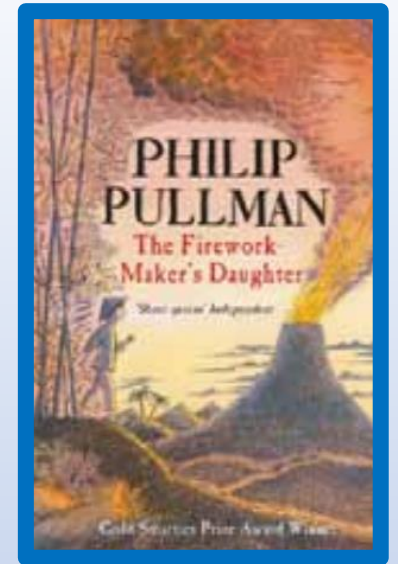
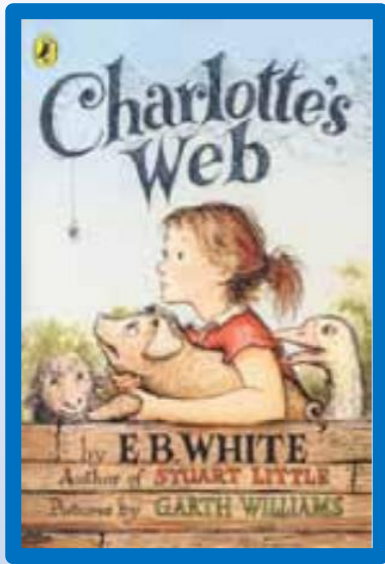
Our main PE day is Monday – the children should come into school in their PE kits on this day.

We are also fifteen minutes daily dose of exercise on the other days of the week when we will enjoy other physical activities and games.

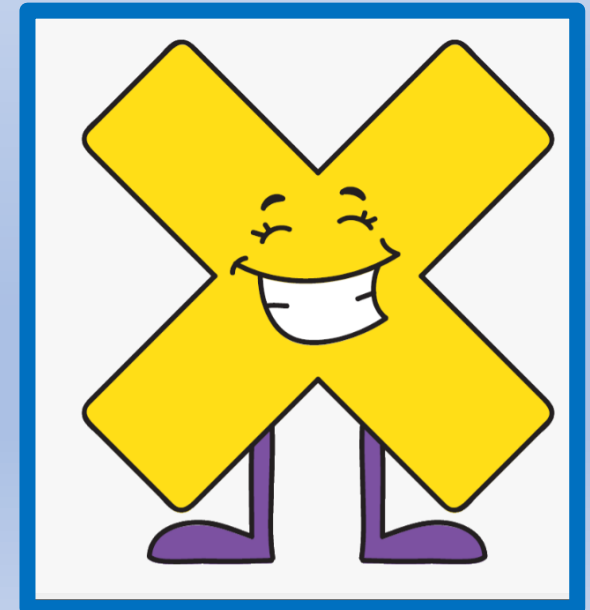
